Things to do to Promote Your Barn

- Whether your barn is a breeding operation, training stable, lesson program or boarding facility you can promote your facility within the industry and to your community.
- *Join your Chamber of Commerce and/or community or business club
- *Host a Business After Hours or Good Morning program

- *Talk to your local schools about field trips or presentations (Grade Schools/Pre-Schools/Daycares)
- *Host birthday parties or other festive events
- *Have a booth at trade/information fairs
- *Have an open house

- *Donate farm visits to local charitable organization auctions
- *Start a youth club and/or a parents club and have fun and/or educational activities at horse shows and community events
- *Host riding camps for adults and/or children
- *Talk to your fellow horsemen to get ideas that worked for them
